#### Range Rules

There are a couple of word changes that have been made to the Clubs Range Rules, these are not new but add a little clarity to avoid confusion.

Insurance to Shoot - Please remember that only GVA Club Members are insured to shoot on our ranges. Non-members are very welcome to attend with a club member to be the 'second adult' and "look-out" but cannot shoot. Archers with AGB or another archery affiliation may shoot on Club Target Days, with a green fee of £5.

Three Arrow Ends Winter Shooting – as we have moved to indoor rounds which are mostly 3 arrow ends and on club target days (Saturday and Sunday) the main range will be 3 arrow ends, for all indoor rounds and 300 scheme except for the Worcester which is 5 arrow ends! If you wish to shoot 6 arrows you can do so at other times if all in attendance agree or at the weekend on the long and training ranges.



Another reason we shoot only 3 arrows is due to the smaller targets and shorter distances. If you are having a good day and all your arrows end up in the gold, you will struggle to fit more than 3 arrows in the 10. Wasting potential opportunity for a higher score.



Golf Ball collection at Weekends - The arrangement for weekend ball collection has been slightly changed during these times we need to stop shooting. On Saturdays normally no ball collection until after 3pm. On Sundays a short 20-minute collection at 12:00 and one after 3pm if needed. But we can also agree changes to accommodate events like the Christmas Fun Shoot or Coaching Clinics etc. Smoking and Vaping – the club's policy does not allow smoking or vaping on any of the club's ranges and ask members to move to the putting green if they wish too. We appreciate this is an inconvenience but is only fair to other club members and as well as not encouraging younger members by vaping in their presence.

Target Faces - Now we have moved to indoor rounds and the windier weather has arrived please remove ALL target faces after use to prevent them being blown off and littering the ranges and golf centre and avoid the risk of them blowing onto the road and possibly obscuring a driver's vision.
