In Case of Emergency

With the safety measures and rules in place at the range, we can be confident that overall, it is a safe sports environment. Despite this, rare accidents and injuries can happen or people become unwell and need urgent medical attention.





We would ask you to consider using the emergency contact information on your mobile

phone to help others to help you if and when you need it. This information can be accessed by a third party even from your locked mobile phone. The emergency contact information can also include your medical status, medication etc.

This of course will have a wider application than just when you are at the archery range.

If you don't have a mobile phone or want help with setting up the emergency contact information on your phone, then please speak to Trevor Benjamin or Trevor Gibbs Here are the instructions for setting up your smart phone for the three main phone platforms.

Android

Navigate to and open Settings, then tap Safety and Emergency, and then tap Emergency contacts. Tap Add emergency contact, and then select from your available contacts or search for someone. Then, tap Done.

Apple IOS

Open the Health app, tap your profile picture, go to "Medical ID," and tap "Edit" to add or remove contacts, medical information etc.

Windows

Unfortunately, Windows phones don't support ICE contacts in the same way. But you can still provide ICE information by including it in your lock screen image along with any medical conditions.

How to access ICE information on someone's phone in an emergency when locked is displayed in the club hut on the club range. But is basically: -

For Emergency Contact and Medical information tap "Emergency" on the lock screen to show keypad. Then select "Medical ID" on iPhones or the siren icon on some Androids to view emergency contacts and medical details.
